As I'm sure you know, we have been learning about aspects of Anglo-Saxon life through our curriculum topic "Where my Wellies Take Me" over the course of this term. To help conclude our work we have arranged a visit to the Weaver Hall Museum to take part in a day of activities based around our Anglo-Saxons topic. This provides the children with a fantastic opportunity to put into practice things they have learnt as well as experience aspects of Anglo-Saxon life that wouldn't otherwise be possible in school.
