COVID measures whilst we are in Menai.

Dear Parents and Carers,

As we prepare to visit Menai there are just some items which we need to be very clear and open about before we go regarding COVID and procedures.

Do not send your child if -

- They are waiting for the results of a PCR test as a member of the household has symptoms or has tested positive on a lateral flow. Once results are through we will advise of next steps.
- They themselves have symptoms, you need to take them for a PCR immediately and call us with results and we will advise next steps.
- You have recently returned from abroad and you are awaiting the day two PCR test result, again please call us when you receive the result.
- Your child has had a positive lateral flow, book a PCR, again call us with results and we will advise next steps.
- If someone in your household develops symptoms and tests positive in the first 48 hours of us being away you MUST inform school and make arrangements for your child to be collected from Menai and be taken for a PCR test.
- Please also remember that if your child has sickness or diarrhoea they will be unable to attend during the 48 hours after their last bout of sickness or diarrhoea, you may of course bring them along once their 48 hours are completed.
- Staff will of course continue to complete their testing whilst away.

All children are to take a lateral flow test on the morning of our Menai trip and email the result to our Covid email. covid@wittonwalk.cheshire.sch.uk
Please state your child's name, date of birth and the result. We will keep these in our first aid documents for Menai which are kept secure under the data protection act.

Please ensure your child packs their own handgel which is travel size and also a couple of packets of travel sized tissues.



Anyone who has a medical condition must meet with Mrs Magiera at least two weeks BEFORE the trip. Please call the office to arrange this. If this meeting has not been had your child will not be able to attend the trip. This includes asthma.

If your child develops one of the three main symptoms whilst we are away they will be isolated away from the group, you will be called and you must collect your child immediately and take them for a PCR test. You just always **need to** be available on the phone in case we need you in such an emergency.
