This is part of the charity, the Diana Award. The Diana Award was founded as a legacy to Diana, Princess of Wales' belief that young people have the power to change the world for the better. The charity works on a number of different projects aimed at reducing bullying in schools. One of the main projects is the Anti-Bullying Ambassadors programme which has trained over 15,000 young people across the UK to lead on anti-bullying campaigns in their schools.

We have chosen your child to become an Anti-Bullying Ambassador as we believe they uphold the qualities required, these being, caring, approachable, confident, brave, promoting kindness and are keen to stop bullying.

In order to become an Anti-Bullying Ambassador your child will need to attend a regional training, this will be held at **Rudheath Senior Academy** on the **Wednesday 6th November 9am – 3:30pm**

The children will leave the day feeling inspired and full of fantastic ideas! The event will cover:

- Understanding the issue of bullying; facts, the definition and the effects of bullying
 - Practical ideas, top tips and explore scenarios on bullying in groups
- Basic training looking at the skills needed to support others and stay safe
- Online safety and approaches students and staff can take to staying safe online and educating their peers
- A networking session with students from other schools to share ideas
- Video examples of schools we currently work with
- Action planning – helping students to think of a plan to take back to school and set targets and aims for their Anti-Bullying work
- Plus lots more including fun games...!
